Summary

We will help you hear new details in music you love and then incorporate those details into your own creations. We will be in your corner as throughout the composition process, and we'll help fill in skills that will allow you to reach your goals.

Technical requirements

- Computer (laptop or desktop)
- Stable broadband internet access
- Webcam
- Speakers or headphones
- Microphone, or headphones with a built- in microphone
- Scanner or scanner app
- Staff paper and pencil

Please note that professional notation software such as Sibelius, Finale, or Dorico is not required but students are welcome to use it if they are comfortable. We are unable to provide technical assistance with this software.

Schedule

These lessons will meet for 55 minutes over Zoom. Further scheduling questions will be determined by the package purchased and the time slot for which the student is registered. No classes will be held March 25-31.
